Prospective Randomised Clinical Trials

- School interventions to reduce the prevalence of tobacco use and to encourage sensible alcohol consumption.
- Study comparing selective neck dissection with no neck dissection in T1/2 N0 Oral SCC.
- Studies on adenoid cystic carcinoma and ameloblastoma.
